Should there be any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this society and the regulations appearing in any schedule, the constitution, rules and regulations appearing in the schedule of this Society shall prevail,

All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.

THE IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY

- a) Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. - All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Ipswich Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.

ALL ENTRY FORMS AND PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SHOW OFFICE NO LATER THAN 8:30AM ON FRIDAY 15TH MAY 2019.

JUDGING: Commencing at 9:30am on Friday 15th May 2020

PRIZE MONEY: First = \$3 / Second = \$2 (*unless otherwise stated*)

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 (Prizes only given if 2 or more entries in class
OR at Judges discretion)

SPECIAL NOTE: All Exhibits must be staged by 9:00am on Friday 15th May. Pot Plants, Hanging Baskets and Orchids must be staged by Thursday night (14th May) at 7:30pm. If help is required, exhibitor must be at Pavilion by 6:30pm. Every Exhibitor **MUST** complete the entry form/Plant Movement Declaration attached to the entry form with all entries.

***** To be eligible for Champion there must be at least 3 entries in each section**

e.g. Hanging Baskets, 3 Single Gerberas etc. ***

REGULATIONS

- 1) Exhibitors are requested to note that Judges will commence their work punctually and Exhibits not in position will not be considered.
- 2) Exhibits may be removed between 8:00am and 11:00am Monday, 18th May 2020.
- 3) With the exception of the Floral Section (Classes 121 - 152), all Exhibits must have been grown by the Exhibitor. Pot Plants must be the property of the Exhibitor for three (3) months and size of plants and pots must balance. Orchids must be owned and in possession of the Exhibitor for 6 months.
- 4) Cut Flowers and Floral work will be staged in Bottles and Vases supplied by the Society. Bowls front view. Vases and Jugs to be supplied by the Exhibitor.
- 5) Hanging Baskets to be judged according to foliage and growth.
- 6) Exhibitors may enter more than one exhibit in each class.
- 7) The Society will take every reasonable care of all Exhibits in its possession, but will not be responsible for any damage thereto or loss thereof.
- 8) In hearing of all protests arising out of entries not being in accordance with the rules of the Society. The decision of the Committee shall be final.
- 9) All background material used in the displays to be in position and completed by 9:30pm Thursday, prior to show.
