Should there be any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this society and the regulations appearing in any schedule, the constitution, rules and regulations appearing in the schedule of this Society shall prevail,

All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.

THE IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY

- a) Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. Failure to comply with lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee or Staff or use of verbal or physical abuse will result in Disciplinary Action which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Ipswich Showgrounds.
- b) Will appoint Judges whose decisions are final and for which no verbal or written communication will be accepted or entered into.
- c) Reserves the right to make any decisions, inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry as it may deem fitting without further notice.
- d) **Entering of Competitions does not constitute free admission entry into the Ipswich Show.**

- All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Ipswich Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO GROUNDS

- No Glass is to be brought on the Grounds. (Other than entries into sections that require glass jars/bottles.)
- All electrical leads must be tagged in accordance with the relevant industrial regulations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Please be aware that you, upon entering the Showgrounds, must follow all directives supported by legislation. including the WHS ACT and Regulations, COVID 19 Emergency Response ACT 2020 and all QCAS Member Societies and Sub Chambers.

- ❖ In conjunction with General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of Schedule
- ❖ No birds showing signs of sickness, disease or parasite infestation will be allowed to be penned.
- ❖ Birds 12 months old and over will be judged as adults.
- ❖ No Bird is allowed to have leg bands.
- ❖ Exhibitors are not to talk to Judges during judging.
- ❖ Should any dispute arise which no special rule is laid down the matter shall be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final.
- ❖ Junior Section open to exhibitors 15 years of age and under who are able to pen their own fowls.

- ❖ All Poultry must be penned between the hours of **2:00pm and 7:30pm, Thursday 13th May, or by prior arrangements with Chief Stewards.**
- ❖ Once having penned an exhibit, no exhibitor may interfere or remove same from coop without the consent of the Chief Steward before 2:00pm on Sunday. All birds must be collected by 5:00pm Sunday or Monday between 8:00am to 10:00am, or by prior arrangements with Chief Stewards.
- ❖ Any birds dyed, interfered with, or wearing rings will be disqualified, and the Exhibitor shall be dealt with as the Committee sees fit.
- ❖ The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, miss-delivery or any damage of Livestock exhibited in this Section.
- ❖ A Champion Certificate may be awarded in each breed, at the discretion of the Judges. Birds in single classes only eligible for major awards. Birds from Junior Section not eligible for Major Awards.
- ❖ The number of entries by each Exhibitor in each class is unlimited.
- ❖ All exhibits not being the bona fide property of the exhibitor shall be disqualified.
- ❖ The Society reserves the right to allocate the Judges as it sees fit.
- ❖ The Pavilion will be closed at 8:00pm each night.
- ❖ No transfers will be affected by the Stewards.
- ❖ Junior Exhibits not eligible for Grand Champion Bird of Show.
