Showgrounds

Ipswich Show Homebrewing Competition 2021 Terms & Conditions

Please be aware that you, upon entering the Showgrounds, must follow all directives supported by legislation. including the WHS ACT and Regulations, COVID 19 Emergency Response ACT 2020 and all QCAS Member Societies and Sub Chambers.

- Entries must be the product of the person entering.
- ❖ All care will be taken with entries but no responsibility will be accepted.
- Special entry labels are available with entry forms supplied, with fee payment of \$5 per entry. Up to 2 (two) bottles required per entry of at least 600mls volume each. PET bottles are acceptable.
- All entries will be judged at appropriate temperatures.
- ❖ Judges will be suitably qualified persons under the Beer Judging Certification Program Guidelines. No person shall judge any class wherein a member of his or her household has entered beer.
- All beers must be sealed with a new gold cap that is not re-used or branded.
- ❖ Judging will include a Bottle Inspection regarding appropriate size, cap, fill level, label removal etc. Comments will be given if bottles do not meet Presentation Standard.
- ❖ The airspace should measure: 750ml = 4.5 to 6.5 (approx. 2") from the top of the bottle / PET = 1" from top of the bottle.
- ❖ All beers should be a reasonable representation of the beer style entered.
- ❖ Details on the Ipswich Show general entry form should correspond with data on the entry label. The "entry number" will be allocated randomly at the point of entry.
- ❖ The decisions of the judges and arbitrator are final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
- ❖ Beers entered out of class will be re-classed unless previously judged.

Entries will be judged using BJCP Guidelines:

- ❖ Beers will be judged against the 2015 BJCP Guidelines below.
- Brewers must specify one of the Styles for each entry.
- The organisers reserve the right to reclassify non-conforming entries to a listed Style.

Grand Champion Beer Terms & Conditions

The winner of the Champion Beer at the Ipswich Show Home Brewing Competition 2021 will be entitled to a Brew Day package at 4 Hearts Brewing in Ipswich. The winner, in consultation with the Head Brewer, will determine a style and recipe to be brewed as a 1200L batch. Where possible, based on the recipe and commercial viability, the beer brewed will in line with the Champion Beer. This style will be discussed and finalised prior to the Brew Day whereas the Head Brewer reserves the final say on the recipe development.

- The Brew Day shall take place on a Tuesday. Where reasonably possible the winner shall be present on the day and participate in the actual brewing process.
- As part of the prize, the winner is also entitled to a Brewer's Lunch with the Head Brewer during the course of the said Brew Day at Dovetails Restaurant.
- Once the beer is ready and packaged the winner will be able to receive two 19L Cornelius Kegs of the finished beer. The winner is required to provide the kegs.
- The winner retains no financial interest in the beer either before or after brewing. The final recipe and name used as part of the brew will remain property of 4 Hearts Brewing to which the winner has no legal claim.
- ❖ 4 Hearts Brewing may cancel the Brew Day at short notice due to a number of reason and requirements and all efforts will be made to reschedule.
