- All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.
- Entrants must comply with the Queensland Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations Act 2011.
- Entrants agree to abide by COVID safe requirements and directions by the Ipswich Show Society Management and adhere to current Queensland COVID-19 restrictions as listed under the Chief Health Officer Public Health Directive.

THE IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY

- Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. Failure to comply with lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee or Staff or use of verbal or physical abuse will result in Disciplinary Action which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Ipswich Showgrounds.
- Will appoint Judges whose decisions are final and for which no verbal or written communication will be accepted or entered into.
- Reserves the right to make any decisions, inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry as it may deem fitting without further notice.
- Entering of Competitions does not constitute free admission entry into the Ipswich Show.
- By way of entering for this Competition exhibitors acknowledge that they are compliant with these Conditions.

ANIMAL/s AND BIRD/S EXHIBITORS

- All animal/s and bird/s exhibitors must sign an EXHIBIT HEALTH DECLARATION upon delivery of entry and must comply with the health requirements detailed in this document.

- All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Ipswich Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.

PRIME CATTLE - RULES AND REGULATIONS

In conjunction with General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of Schedule:

- Cattle will be received at the Ipswich Showgrounds between 2:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Wednesday 11 May to enable all cattle to be penned by 6:00 pm
- Judging commences at 8:00 am on Thursday 12 May. While judging is in progress exhibitors and the public are expected to vacate the judging ring. The Chief Steward is empowered to ask such persons to leave the judging ring.
- Auction Sales commence at 1 pm on Thursday, 12th May. All exhibits must be sold. Cattle may leave grounds immediately after the sale, at approximately 5:30 pm.
- COMMISSION ON SALES A commission of 2.5% on sales of exhibits affected either by Auction or privately either on grounds or elsewhere, during the week of the Show shall be paid to the SOCIETY by the seller of their agents.
- The teeth of all cattle exhibited in the Prime Cattle section must be examined by the Exhibitor or his agent before arrival at the Ipswich Showgrounds. It will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor or his agent to affix the appropriate colored tag to the tail of each beast prior to dispatch to the Saleyards, such tag to indicate the number of permanent teeth erupted. For this show the following colors will be used:
 - No Tag - Milk Tooth Only
 - Blue - Not more than 4 teeth
 - White - Not more than 2 teeth
 - Yellow - Not more than 6 teeth

SELLING AGENTS

- Exhibitors are requested to designate their preferred Agent on their entry form
- Once an agent has been nominated on the entry form it CAN NOT be altered
- Each exhibitor should specify on their Entry Form the number of permanent teeth erupted on each nominated beast, irrespective of the class for which is nominated.
- An estimate of tags required would be appreciated

- Ear tags shall be used for identification
- Ear and tail tags will be supplied by the Society to each Exhibitor after the closure of entries. No animals will be allowed to be penned in any class unless it has the appropriate ear and tail tags and also the registered NLIS and tail tag of the property of origin.
- PLEASE NOTE: Cattle from a herd restricted for with Tuberculosis or Brucellosis will not be allowed entry to the sale yards.
- All exhibitors must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for no less than 60 days prior to the show date.
- The Judges shall take into consideration Breeding, Quality, Conformation, Temperament, and Weight for age, evenness, and depth of flesh, coupled with least waste in all cases in the Prime Cattle Section and shall withhold the award unless in their opinion the Exhibits are of sufficient merit.
- All Horned Cattle must be well tipped prior to their arrival at the sale yards.
- Any entry in female classes showing or proving to be in calf shall be ineligible
- Cattle for single entries may not be taken from any pen
- The Society shall not accept liability for any livestock exhibited. Such liability is strictly that of the Exhibitor.
- Tick infested cattle will not be allowed to compete and must be removed at the order of the Chief Steward.
- Entry fees are as stated. No rebate for Members.
- Any beast found to be incorrectly entered may be transferred to the appropriate class at the discretion of the Stewards.
- All cattle must be clearly and permanently Fire Branded D.P.I Regulations conditions of sale.
- Unless otherwise stated, there are no feeding restrictions for stocked entered in the Prime Beef Section.
- All cattle are to carry an NLIS tag in accordance with current government policy
- Cattle not accompanied by fully completed Waybill as required by the Stock Act - 1915 will be refused entry to the sale yards.

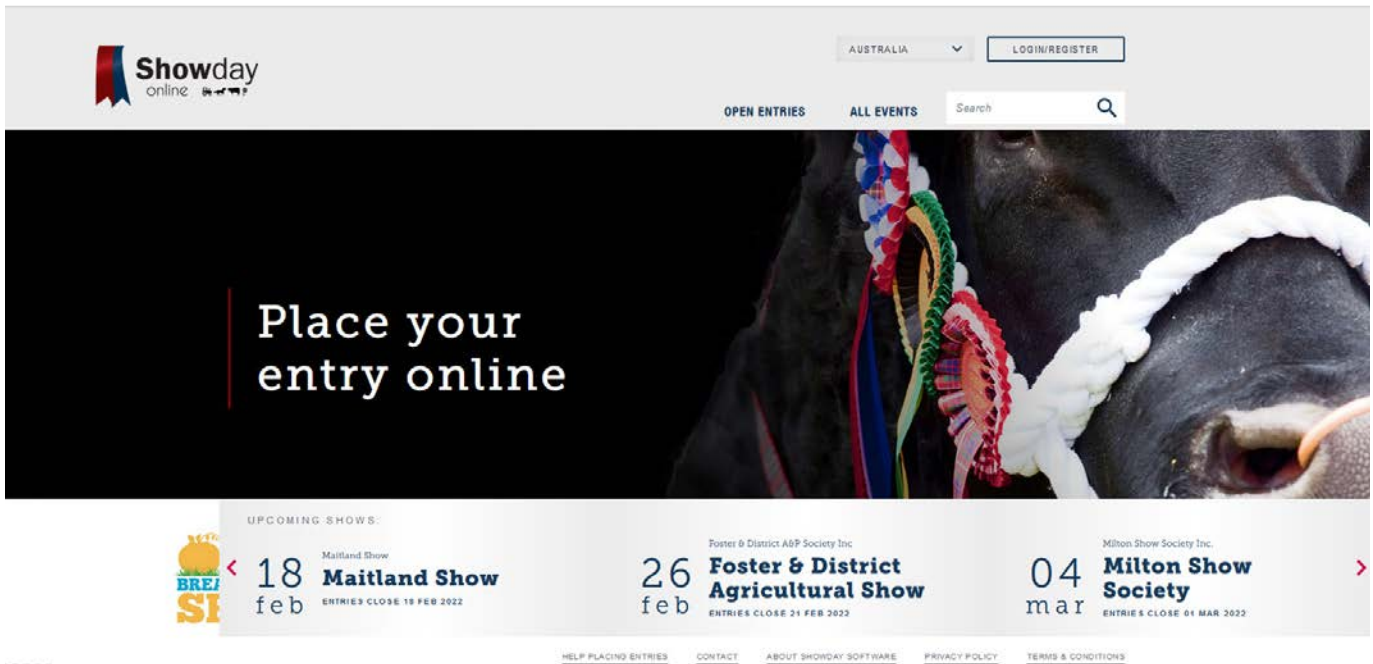

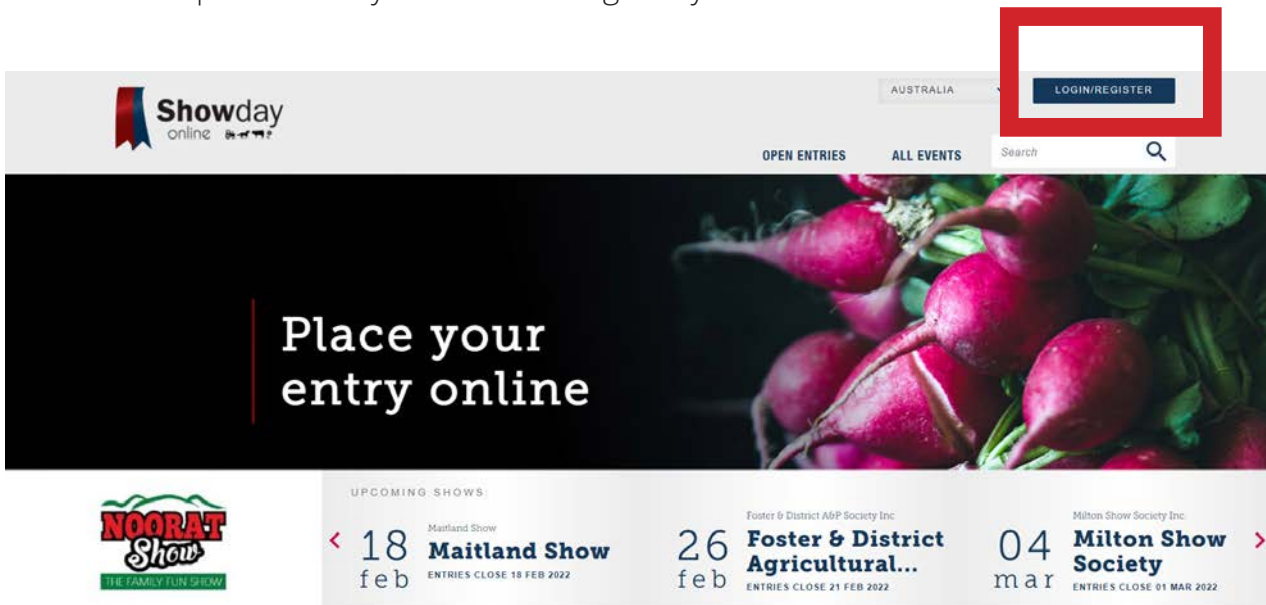
HOW TO ENTER

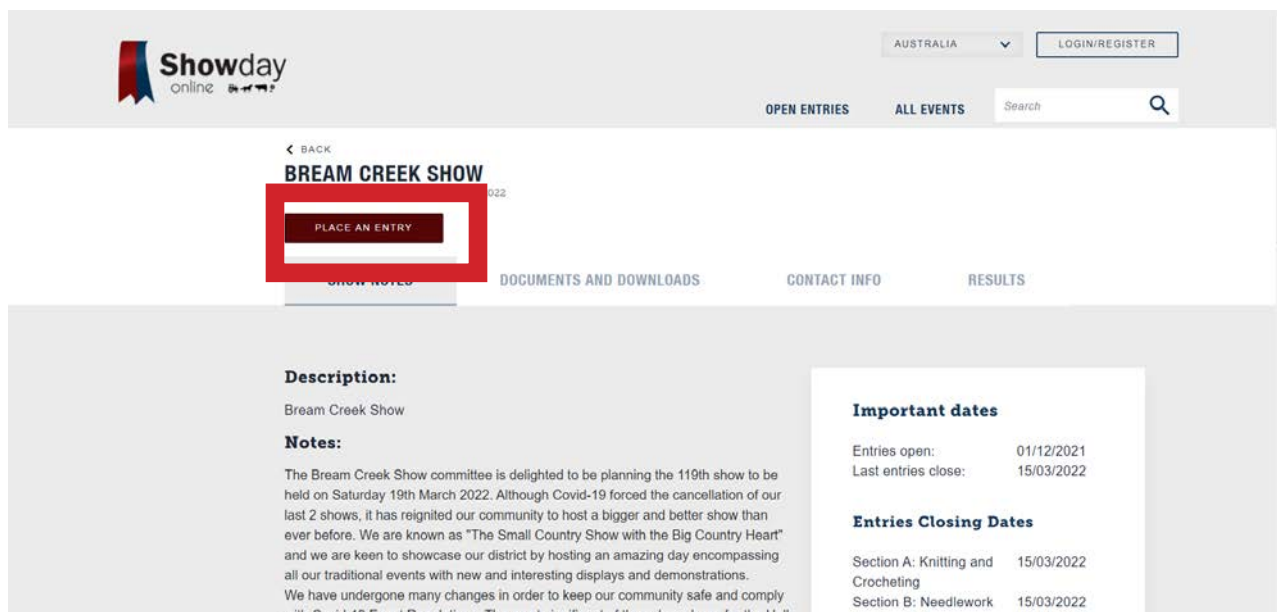
REGISTER

1. When visiting Showday online for the first time you will need to create an account. Single click the Register button. Complete your details and then single click the green Create New Account button.
2. You will need to have the correct punctuation, address info etc, as this information is how all the shows you enter (via Showday.online) will identify you. An individual show cannot change this information once they have received your entry and you are responsible to keep this information up to date on Showday.online.

3. You will receive a welcome email from Showday.online . Follow the directions and setup your Showday.online login password. Then single click the green Save button. If you do not receive this email, please contact Showday via their Contact link -<https://showday.online/contact>.
4. YOU MUST DO THIS TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT
5. Please do not create multiple accounts on Showday.online as each show will have information against accounts already created.
