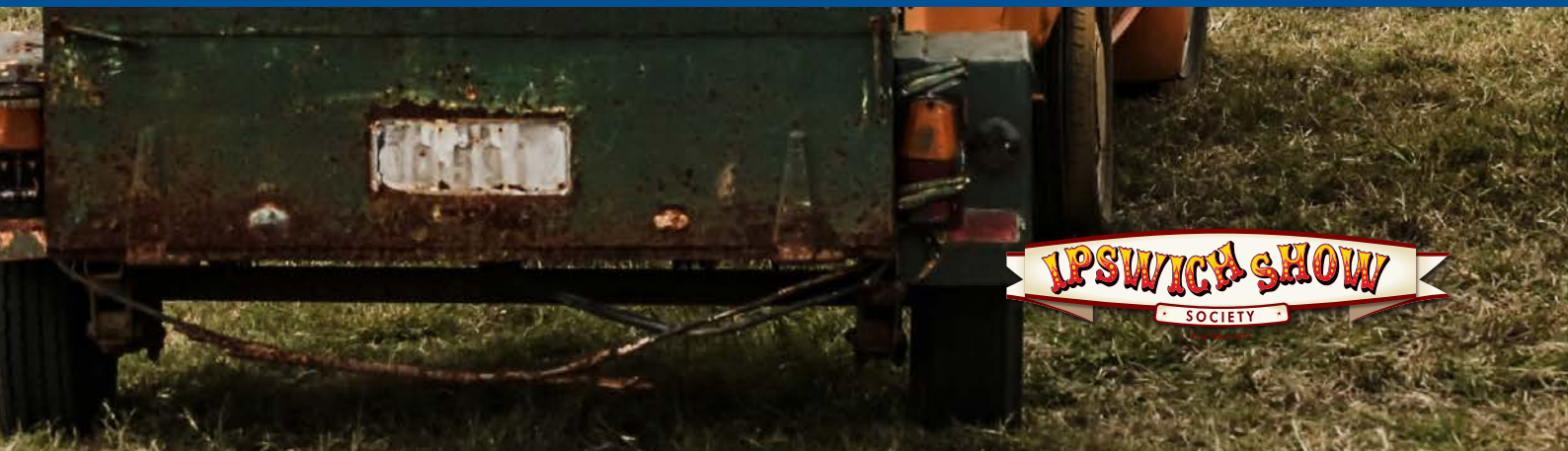

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION**

- This Show is conducted subject to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this Society and any regulation which appears within the Schedule for individual sections of this Show. Should there be any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this society and the regulations appearing in any schedule, the constitution, rules and regulations appearing in the schedule of this Society shall prevail.
- All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.
- Entrants must comply with the Queensland Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations Act 2011.
- Entrants agree to abide by COVID safe requirements and directions by the Ipswich Show Society Management and adhere to current Queensland COVID-19 restrictions as listed under the Chief Health Officer Public Health Directive.

## **THE IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY**

- Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. Failure to comply with lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee or Staff or use of verbal or physical abuse will result in Disciplinary Action which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Ipswich Showgrounds.
- Will appoint Judges whose decisions are final and for which no verbal or written communication will be accepted or entered into.
- Reserves the right to make any decisions, inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry as it may deem fitting without further notice.
- Entering of Competitions does not constitute free admission entry into the Ipswich Show.
- By way of entering for this Competition exhibitors acknowledge that they are compliant with these Conditions.

## **ANIMAL/S AND BIRD/S EXHIBITORS**

- All animal/s and bird/s exhibitors must sign an EXHIBIT HEALTH DECLARATION upon delivery of entry and must comply with the health requirements detailed in this document.

- All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Ipswich Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO GROUNDS**

- No Glass is to be brought on the Grounds. (Other than entries into sections that require glass jars/bottles.)
- All electrical leads must be tagged in accordance with the relevant industrial regulations.

## **DUNNY DERBY| RULES AND CONDITIONS**

ALL COMPETITORS MUST ABIDE BY THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN EXCLUSION FROM THE EVENT

Please be aware that you, upon entering the Showgrounds, must follow all directives supported by legislation. including the WHS ACT and Regulations, COVID 19 Emergency Response ACT 2020 and all QCAS Member Societies and Sub Chambers.

1. 4 CYLINDER FRONT WHEEL DRIVE ONLY – NO BIGGER THAN A LANCER.
2. The Ipswich Show Society reserves the right to accept/refuse an entry.
3. ENTRY FEE for the Dunny Derby is \$35.00 per vehicle. This entitles the driver to one 1-day admission pass for the Show and the passenger to one 1-day admission pass for the Show.
4. Pit Crew will have to pay admission to the Show.
5. Each derby car is to have a driver and passenger, both of whom are 17 years of age or older.
6. All cars must start and finish with a Driver and Passenger, both of whom are 17 years of age or older.
7. If there are any changes to Driver, Passenger or Pit crew after the entry form has been lodged these changes please contact the Chief Steward ASAP.
8. Car must be at the showgrounds, in the parking area off Parker Avenue, between 1:00pm and 3:00pm for car check.
9. Briefing TBC in marshalling yard. All Drivers and Passengers, and Pit Crew MUST attend.
11. Any evidence of Drivers, Passengers, or Pit Crew under the influence of alcohol or drugs will result in Driver, Passenger & car being disqualified from the derby. The Ipswich Show Society has the right to contact the Queensland Police Service to RBT drivers and passengers.
12. Any vehicle deemed to be unsafe for Drivers, Passengers or other competitors may be disqualified at car check or during the event.
13. Helmets with eye protection – All helmets must be AS1698 standard and in good condition, inspect at pre-event meeting.
14. Long sleeve shirts, long trousers and proper shoes must be worn by Drivers and

Passengers. No nylon clothing, including underwear (nylon will melt & stick to skin).

15. Only Driver, Passenger and Pit Crew member will be allowed in centre ring until after derby.

16. You MUST be trying to hit 'dunnies' ONLY at all times.

17. You must remain in your vehicle until derby is complete or until told otherwise by the control car.

18. Seat belt to be on and tight throughout the derby (see vehicle modifications).

19. No intentional ramming into the cars (dunnies only) - offenders will be disqualified from winning.

20. Vehicles stopped for longer than approx. 45 seconds can be disqualified from winning.

21. Dunnies on cars will be used to indicate active vehicles.

22. Cars must vacate the centre ring on the night of the Derby (unless prior arrangements with co-ordinator) and be out of the grounds by 9:00pm

23. No Wheel Spinning Whilst on Dog Track. PENALTY will be - Car will Park in back Straight and Driver and Passenger walk the Remainder of the Presentation on Foot;

## **JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL**

### **DERBY CONTROL:**

•Control car will start the derby: - GREEN LIGHTS ON = Start / keep competing

•During derby: - RED FLASHING LIGHTS = Stop immediately

•A spotlight will be used to disqualify Drivers: -

i. If it is flashed into your car = this is a warning (i.e.: be more careful or do more hitting)

ii. When shone at length into your car = stop competing and report to control car

iii. Do not argue with officials

•Most carby fires etc will burn themselves out in a short time. Control car will not attend unless Driver or Passenger are in danger.

### **VEHICLE SPECIFICATIONS:**

The only allowable modifications to cars are those listed in these specifications. If specifications differ from this sheet, then entry will be disqualified.

• For any modification for safety, or other than listed, see Scrutineer before handing in entry

• No full chassis vehicles

• 25mm x 25mm mesh to be welded to windscreen area,

• BONNET INTRUSION BARS are now compulsory, regardless of whether bonnet is front/rear hinged. Weld 2 x 10mm rods from the firewall to roof, to protect against bonnet coming through between windscreen pillars

• Battery to be securely mounted with a metal bracket on top of the battery with at least two 8mm (5/16) bolts through bracket and car floor with adequate washers and or plate (plate to be larger than battery size and must be between 2mm and 8mm thick). Only one 12-volt battery to be used. Batteries to be mounted behind passenger seat on the floor.

• If re wiring ignition, a grommet must be used when passing through steel panels. (Rubbin of wires can create a fire).

• Must start with a key or switch (no twitching of wires)

• All glass, interior and exterior door handles, badges, grille, chrome strips and alloy surround etc and all flammable linings are to be removed

• Mud guards to be standard (not to be cut away) or welded

• Rims to be manufacturers' diameter for that make and model; tyres can be changed. No alloy wheels or wheel weights.

• Bumper-bar to be in original position; only original bumper mounts to be used. Top of bumper-bar not to be higher than 700mm from the ground.

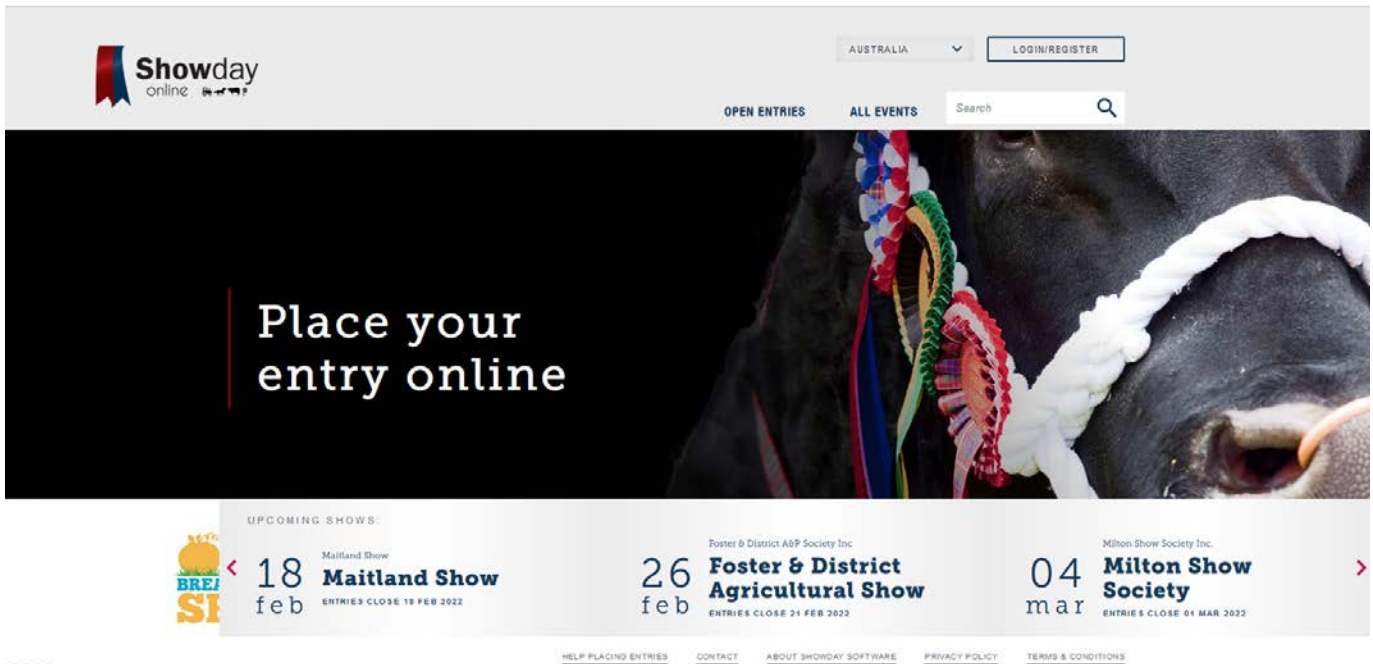
- Radiator to be standard car type; to be in approx. original position; Heater box to be removed or bypassed. No other radiator type devices are to be fitted. Radiator to be filled with water only (NO COOLANT). If stop-leak additives are needed consult with Scrutineer.
- Three-point seat belt for both Driver and Passenger; BOLTED IN – NOT WELDED.
- Vehicles with too much rust may not be allowed to enter.
- Devices to create smoke are not permitted. Vehicles not to be excessively smokey.
- Vehicles to have brakes, minimum 2 wheel lock up
- No spare tyre in vehicle
- Motor and diff not to be changed (Holden motor and diff in Holden etc)
- Accelerator (throttle) must be operated by right foot
- Gearshift to be operated by hand from upright seated position and must have gear knob or T-Bar fitted
- A roof number must be fitted (tin plate 300mm x 200mm screwed to roof not directly above the Driver or Passenger).
- Driver's name to be printed clearly on the roof above Driver's door.
- Fuel injected cars must be fitted with a safety switch for the fuel pump, mounted in the middle of the dash. Must be easily accessible to driver, passenger and officials. Access hole to be cut in mesh.

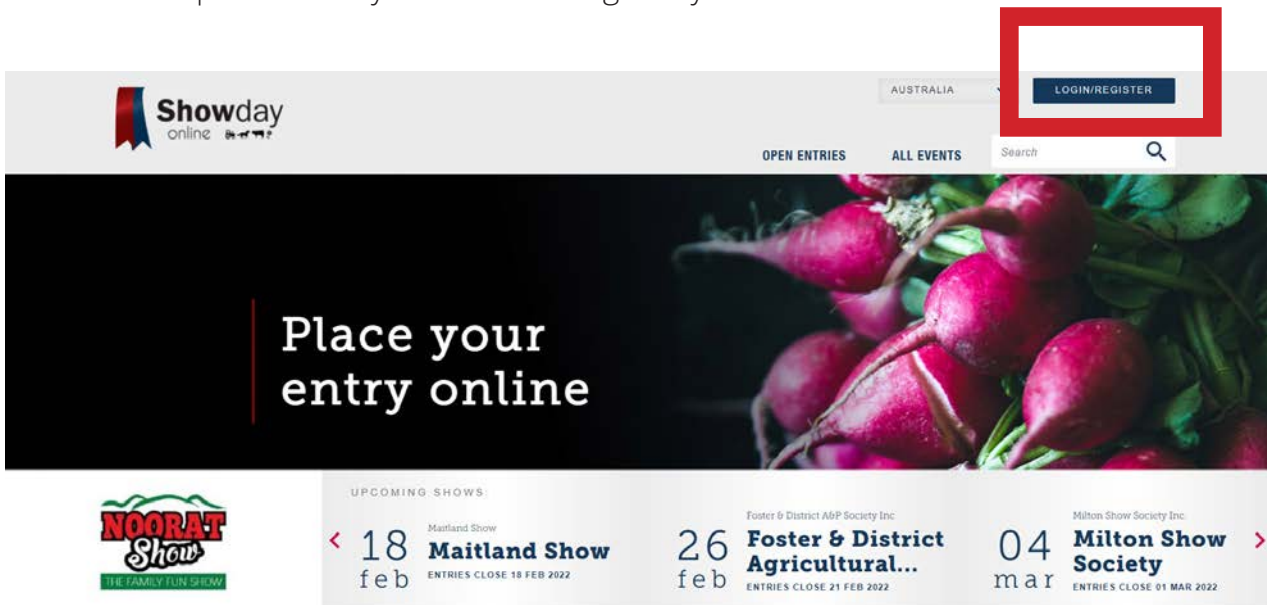
# HOW TO ENTER

## REGISTER

1. When visiting Showday online for the first time you will need to create an account. Single click the Register button. Complete your details and then single click the green Create New Account button.

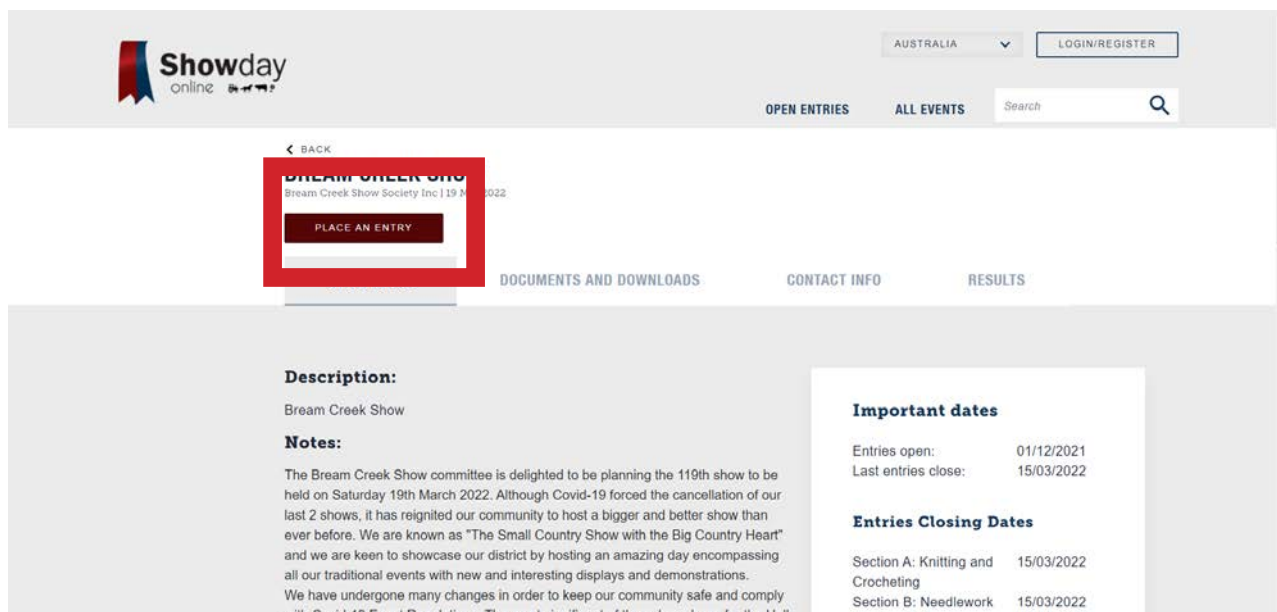
2. You will need to have the correct punctuation, address info etc, as this information is how all the shows you enter (via Showday.online) will identify you. An individual show cannot change this information once they have received your entry and you are responsible to keep this information up to date on Showday.online.



3. You will receive a welcome email from Showday.online . Follow the directions and setup your Showday.online login password. Then single click the green Save button. If you do not receive this email, please contact Showday via their Contact link -<https://showday.online/contact>.
4. YOU MUST DO THIS TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT
5. Please do not create multiple accounts on Showday.online as each show will have information against accounts already created.

## LOG IN AND ENTER

1. Once you have created your account, from the home page, click on the ALL EVENTS tab at the top of the page. A new page will load with a list of Shows, scroll down to Ipswich Show and select.
2. One the page loads click on the PLACE AN ENTRY on the top left to begin entering.



3. Click on Individual or Group Entry
4. Fill Entrant - Add new entrant and enter your details
5. Click on Name and Exhibit type
6. Select the Section and Classes you wish to enter
